Proof of negative coggins taken after 1-1-10 is required. Bring original and copy for show office or copies .50c. Stallions must be handled by exhibitor age 18 or over. Dogs MUST be on leash at all times and kept in trailer area. Tack changes must be requested at the entry table at least 2 classes in advance of when needed. Gate will be held 2 minutes for requested changes. Per 4-H rules, ALL EXHIBITORS must be in **Grade 3 or over** to be able to participate at this show! **ALL exhibitors (Adults and Youth) are REQUIRED to wear SEI Approved helmets when mounted.** Boots and Proper attire required.

All decisions of the show committee and the judge are final. The show committee reserves the right to cancel or combine classes at their discretion. All entrants agree that they will not hold the Show Committee responsible for any loss to personal possessions, injuries or death to horses or riders exhibiting at this show. Under Wi.
